Description: In late September, SSAISD welcomed a new director on board. Within a span of four months, we successfully procured classroom resources to enhance the learning experience of our early learning scholars. However, there remains a balance of \$185,214 in our accounts. The Head Start department at SSAISD has put forth a request to carry over these remaining funds into the next fiscal year. This carryover will allow us to invest in essential updates for our classrooms, outdoor playing equipment, and supplies, with the goal of establishing a cutting-edge STEM learning environment that prioritizes the safety, responsiveness, and overall nurturing of our community's preschoolers.

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Carryforward Request

1. Summary

South San Antonio Independent School District (SSAISD) Head Start Program requests a carryforward application and budget request from SSAISD for the Head Start Grant #06CH010831 unexpended funds from FY4 in the amount of \$185,214.00 in CAN 4122 and \$2,845 in CAN 4120 from the budget period 2022-2023. The chart shown in the budget justification section indicates where the remaining account balances were not utilized. The carryforward funds will be repurposed/transferred from their original obligated accounts into the travel and general supplies accounts in order to purchase, support, and engage our young scholars with fine and gross motor skills, social skills, kinder readiness skills, outdoor playground equipment, and classroom resources that will support early childhood learning environments and the district curriculum.

2. Plan for Carryforward Funding

With the new director coming in late September, there was a period of transition time where we as a district and department had to pick up and learn the standards, policies, and vision that was in place in order to support the needs of the students, classrooms, and staff. This period indicates why many of our funds were underutilized during the last four months of FY four which ended in January 2023. Under contracted services category (\$32,110.07), Gen Supplies (\$59,406.62), Travel (\$49,175.82), Other (\$44,402.41), Capital Outlay (\$39.00), and Indirect Cost (\$11,716.00) that remained in the SSAISD Head Start accounts.

South San ISD Head Start Department would like these funds moved/transferred to Travel (\$25,000.00), and general supplies (\$160,214.00) in order to support updated and new educational resources and supplies that can enhance the delivery of hands-on and interactive instruction for our students. Resources purchased through these funds will include but are not limited STEMnasium

classrooms, Magna Tiles, Bee-Bots (coding), Tangram Puzzles, the Lite Zilla for fine and gross

motor skills and much more. Additional reasons why funds were left in the accounts were due to

partnership with the City of San Antonio for support on professional development through

PreK4SA, not traveling out of town for conferences except the Family Engagement, coordination

of program/funds, and reassessing the needs of the students and program.

With the carryforward funds, SSAISD will support the campuses by purchasing different

resources for a STEMnasium classroom where the focus is on hands-on learning with real-world

applications that help develop various skill sets, including creativity and 21st-century skills. These

important skills include but are not limited to media and technology literacy, productivity, social

skills, communication, flexibility, and initiative. Other skills our young scholars will attain through

the STEMnasium classroom include problem-solving, critical thinking, creativity, curiosity,

decision-making, leadership, entrepreneurship, acceptance of failure, and more, regardless of the

future career path these children choose.

Lastly, SSAISD had \$2,845.00 in TTA funds. We would like for the TTA funds to continue

to support the SSAISD Head Start program professional development plan we currently have in

place with understanding age-appropriate instruction with the LETRS, FrogStreet, Second STEP,

and the Science of Reading initiatives. This will allow teachers to expand their skills and

knowledge and grow as educators. It will also give them a better understanding of our early

childhood scholars, and challenge them in and out of the classroom.
