

Child Nutrition CSP 110113 for Commodity Processing

February 15, 2011

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of CSP 110113 for Child Nutrition Commodity Processing for the 2011-12 school year.

BOARD GOAL:

VI. Growth and Change...a. demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources.

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

February 9, 2010 the Board approved the 2010-11 bid as recommended.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Bidders submit all of the services they provide. However, our district does not use all of the types of processing. The types used are noted on the summary sheets.

Proposals were submitted by Advance Pierre Foods, Alpha Foods, Asian Food Solutions, Barrel O'Fun Snack Foods, Best Express Foods, Bongards, Bosco's Pizza, Cavendish Farms, ConAgra Foods Chuck Gentile, ConAgra Foods Lamb Weston, Culinary Standards, ES Foods, Fieldale Farms, Giorgio Foods, Icelandic USA, Integrated Food Service, JTM Provisions, JOY Foods, Jennie-O Turkey Store Sales, King's Command Foods, Kings Delight, Land O'Lakes, Lux Bakery, MCI Foods, McCain Foods, Nardone Bros Baking Co, Pilgrim's Pride, Red Gold, Rich Products, Schwan's Food Service, JR Simplot, Tyson, Quantum, and Wawona.

Pricing was submitted as a Fee for Service or Net off Invoice. It will depend upon the commodities actually processed as to how much will be spent.

Pricing was reviewed and each category of processing was given to the processor with the best over-all pricing.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

Commodity Processing for the 2011-12 year must be approved by the end of February 2011.

The best over all pricing was submitted as follows;

Tyson – Beef, Jennie-O – Turkey, Tyson Food – Chicken, JR Simplot – Potatoes, Wawona - Fruit.

The district will have enough rollover barrel and mozzarella cheese for next year, so we don't need to order a truck in these categories.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Costs will be borne by the Child Nutrition Budget.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

Passage will allow the district to process the commodities it receives.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that commodity processing be awarded for the 2011-12 school year to Tyson Foods for beef, Jennie-O Turkey Sales for turkey, Tyson Foods for chicken, J. R. Simplot for potatoes, and Wawona for fruit.
