

2020/2021 Browning High School Prom Proposal

COVID19 Prom Protocols-

- Under the terms of the Blackfeet Tribal and Browning School Board directives, the "sponsor" of an event is responsible for ensuring compliance with applicable requirements issued by the Blackfeet Tribe and Browning School Board and/or the local Health Department, including but not limited to the use of masks and the maintenance of appropriate physical social distancing throughout the entirety of the event. For purposes of athletic events and activities, the School District of the home event is deemed to be the sponsor of the activity and is therefore responsible for ensuring compliance with the requirements by all in attendance, including employees, student participants, and essential parents. The aim of this plan is to mitigate and manage the range of risks associated with school sports and activities, while acknowledging that there will likely be cases or possible exposures associated with these activities.
- All Participants at the event will be required to wear masks at all times including outdoors and indoors.
- All workers, officials, and students will be screened upon arrival for signs / symptoms of COVID-19 prior to participating. Any person with positive symptoms reported should not be allowed to participate, should self-isolate, and contact their primary care provider or other health-care professional. Screening tools will be provided along with daily logs from the Prom event set-up.
- Symptoms to watch for include but are not limited to: fever, cough and shortness of breath. (see screening tool).

Prom April 10, 2021 7:30-10:30pm

The Prom event will be held in the BHS Gym, utilizing the same route as previous prom events. Students will walk in through the entrance by the Home Ec area. There each participant (student, staff, chaperone, security, parent) will be screened (see form - will be changed to reflect audience)

Parent viewing

- Have a separate route for parents to enter and view the cafeteria and students coming in.
- They will have to comply with expectations
- There will be a time limit for visitors.

Expectations

- Throughout the entire Prom process we will be FOLLOWING COVID PROCEDURES
 established for BHS through our MTSS expectations. (see sign-we will create one especially
 for PROM)
 - Chaperones will be on the dance for monitoring COVID protocols
 - Mainly fast paced songs played
 - Ventilation in the gym is in place, will add purifiers in other areas as needed
 - Signage and floor decals will be in place in high traffic areas (pictures, entrance, dance area, food area)
- We will also have mandatory sessions with all classes about Prom Expectations as well as a form for all parents to sign regarding expectations for students to comply (will have created)
- Students may be asked to leave for noncompliance
 - Theme "Garden Glamour" Gold, Pink and Purple (sunset colors)
 - ❖ Tickets: \$20/each will go on sale after spring break NO GUESTS, MUST BE BHS/BHA STUDENTS
 - Eligibility Students need to be actively attending school
 - Music Local DJ (have them do interaction with the crowd with dances)
 - Food Grab and go, packaged snacks eaten in the lobby
 - Pictures Local photographer
