

## Budget Priorities:

The following priorities were taken from three entities: the Beaverton School Board, Community (families and educators), and the members of the Strategic Budget Team. The 'All' category represents priorities that were emphasized by each group. Each item on the All list were stricken from the individual group lists.

Important to note: Not all priorities of each group are listed, but rather only the top three to five.

<b>Beaverton School Board</b>	
<b>College &amp; Career Ready:</b>	Resources, supports and course offerings that have the <u>closest</u> connection to our District goal of students being college and career ready.
<b>Class Size:</b>	Prioritize class size, starting with the primary grades and investing in early childhood partnerships, while considering class size in MS & HS that facilitates student learning in core content areas that we can sustainably afford.
A1	Equity: prioritize schools receiving equitable resources, differentiating dollars beyond a common base level for schools in need determined by academic achievement
A2	Individual Student Achievement: ensuring teachers have the appropriate supports, tools and time for purposeful collaboration to focus their efforts on individualizing education
A3	Technology: 1) ensuring a secure district-wide infrastructure 2) integrating proven technology tools into classroom instruction 3) enhancing parent involvement in student achievement
