**Yvonne Diaz**, district PEIMS Coordinator, received a Perfect PID Award from the Region Education Service Center II, for the PEIMS 2004-2005 Fall/Submission 1.

The Person Identification Database (PID) system is used by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) to manage and store identifying information on teachers and students who are reported to TEA through the Public Education Information Management Systems (PEIMS). The purpose of the PID system is to ensure that each time data is collected for the same person, certain elements of basic identifying information match. The identifying elements consist of the social security number, first, middle and last name, gender, date of birth and ethnicity.

The PID Error Rate standard is 10 or fewer student records with PID errors or a PID error rate on student records of 2.0% or lower. BISD had an error rate of 0.0% with 0 PID errors. BISD also met the error rate standard of 0.0% for the 2003-2004 Summer/Submission 3 and the 2003-2004 Fall/Submission 1 reporting periods.
