Jeff Wood Little Rock On May 17, 2023, the Division of Elementary and Secondary Education ("the Division") notified you via email that the Division had found the Cutter Morning Star School District ("the District") to be in violation of the Standards for Accreditation of Arkansas Public

Schools and School Districts for the following reasons:

- Violation of Standard 2-B.2, which states that "[e]ach public school shall maintain accurate student attendance records in a format prescribed by the Division." (D/P). Specifically, the Division identified nineteen (19) dually enrolled students who are receiving instruction from All Children's Academy and no instruction from the District. The District staff indicated that they did not receive daily attendance records, but all nineteen (19) students were marked present in eSchool at the District each day.
- Violation of Standard 3-A.3, which states that "[e]ach public school shall submit accurate and timely reports deemed necessary to assure compliance with federal and state law and the rules of the Division, as requested." (D/C). Specifically, the Division identified nineteen (19) dually enrolled students who are receiving instruction from All Children's Academy and no instruction from the District. The District staff indicated that they did not receive daily attendance records, but all nineteen (19) students were marked present in eSchool at the District each day. The District received funding based on increased enrollment.

The Division received the District's appeal on June 2, 2023. The Division will recommend to the Arkansas State Board of Education that it place the District on Accredited-Probation status for the violation of Standard 2-B.2. The Division will also recommend to the State Board that the District be placed on Accredited-Cited status for the violation of Standard 3-A.3. A hearing on this matter will take place at the State Board meeting on **Thursday July 13, 2023, at 9 a.m.** in the Auditorium of the Arch Ford Education Building, Four Capitol Mall, Little Rock, AR 72201.

The hearing will be conducted pursuant to the authority vested in the State Board of Education by Ark. Code Ann. § 6-15-201 et seq., and the Division of Elementary and Secondary Education Rules Governing Standards for Accreditation of Arkansas Public Schools and School Districts. The District officials who can respond to the State Board's questions should attend the hearing. If the State Board places the Cutter Morning Star School District on Accredited-Probation status, it may take any of the actions listed in Ark. Code Ann. § 6-15-207(c).
