Update on remaining summer programs:

BHS/BMS Summer Project

Two weeks ago we completed our final GEAR UP summer program – a virtual IT class (Raspberry Pi in Isolation) that was taught as a partnership between one BMS and one BHS IT teacher. Our goal was 15 students but we ended up with 9 students – 6 middle school and 3 high school.
