The Kaufman ISD maintenance team has continued to work on improvement projects around the district. In addition to those projects, there were over 200 campus based work orders that were completed during the month of March.

Here are a few of the projects that the team has been working on this month:



This month, the maintenance crew worked on improving drainage around the district. Here the team uses some heavy equipment to cut some new channels. These new pathways will better direct the rain water around the tennis courts.





In March, the crew took some time to re-mulch the playgrounds at Nash and Phillips. The team dispersed over 1500 bags of mulch during the operation. Looks good!





The maintenance crew teamed up with contractors to clear the land from one of the district properties. An 8 foot fence was then built to keep the facility secure.
