6.1 Facility Projects

S. Strasser updated the committee on the Activity & Fitness Center. Construction is in the substantial completion phase and closing out punchlist items. Final inspections for occupancy are scheduled for Friday, November 21. There will be an Open House on December 10th from 5:30-7:00pm. Membership sales start December 1st and the Fitness Center will officially open on Friday, January 2nd. S. Strasser shared the progress and timeline for the Irving Playground Project. S. Strasser informed the committee that the district is exploring options for outdoor facility improvements at FLW to better serve the school day and athletics district wide. The committee discussed the City of West Allis' inquiry to explore the use of and access to the school district's facility scheduling software system for scheduling of City Parks and amenities. The committee determined licensing regulations and access liability need to be explored and deferred the item for future consideration.

6.2 Athletic Strategic Plan

S. Strasser updated the committee on progress made in addressing survey feedback regarding communication and the celebration of athletic success'. Strategic cross department collaboration between the athletics team and communications team is ongoing and proving to be beneficial. The uniform replacement plan has been finalized and adopted for implementation in the 2025-2026 school year with a four year cycle planned. The athletics team continues to monitor, assess and discuss options for strengthening the junior feeder programs district wide.
