



2017 – 18 CALENDAR PROPOSALS

NOVEMBER 7, 2016

HB 2610

- No longer 180 instructional days, with waivers
- 75,600 minutes of instruction
- Waivers no longer available for weather, staff development, etc.
- Start/end times must change for Elementary (7:40 – 3:00; 8:15 – 3:35)

TRADITIONAL CALENDAR

- All Levels have a uniform calendar
- Start date of August 28th
- One ½ day and one full day for parent conferences (teacher prep)
- Last day of school June 6th, with Graduation on June 7th
- 23 more days in 2nd semester
- 2 Built-In weather days
- Alignment of Spring Break with local universities

DOI CALENDAR

- All Levels have a uniform calendar
- Shortened first week of school
- One ½ day and one full day for parent conferences (teacher prep)
- 2 Built-In weather days
- Last day of school + Graduation prior to Memorial Day
- Alignment of Spring Break with local universities
- More comparable days in fall and spring semester (80 full + 3 ½ and 91 full + 2 ½)
- Maximize use of instructional days prior to state testing
- 4 PLC days built in throughout the year

INPUT PROVIDED FROM DISTRICT LEADERSHIP, CAMPUS ADMINISTRATORS AND EIC

Positive Feedback:

- Alignment of Spring Break
- Graduation prior to Memorial Day (DOI)
- Two ½ days mid-week prior to Winter Break (DOI)
- Shortened first week (DOI)
- PLC time built-in throughout the school year (DOI)

Additional Considerations:

- Collaborate with local childcare facilities regarding ½ days
- Conference schedule changes will require a different mindset
- Consideration for 9 week grading period for elementary
- Loss of one day of holiday over Winter Break (DOI)
