Re: Student Device Purchase Recommendation

On February 1st, the District received quotes on student devices from multiple vendors. Prices for devices with a warranty ranged from a low of \$387.41 to a high of \$755.98. After reviewing all responses and considering all device configurations, we are recommending the procurement of the equipment identified in Table 1. This purchase recommendation is aligned with the approved 2022-23 Technology Capital Plan's line item regarding student device updates. This recommendation seeks approval to purchase these devices outright as outlined in the capital plan.

The total projected amount was: \$713,825. The actual purchase amount, pre-offset, is approximately \$(17,000) under projections. The district did receive grant funding in the amount of \$138,600 to support the purchase of 1:1 devices for Kindergarten. This reduces the district's funding need to \$557,846.25. This year's device configurations include two key

upgrades: Increased system memory (8GB vs 4GB) and a digital pen that is housed in the device. This price and configuration combination offers the most value to students.
