FY26 Initial Payments were received in December, totaling \$1,705,128

Fall 2025 ANSEP

We had 49 students from Ambler(4), Buckland(14), Kivalina(4), KMHS(21), Noatak(2), Noorvik(1), Selawik(3), participate in the Fall ANSEP Session. This seven-day academy at the University of Anchorage allowed the students to build a computer, construct an earthquake-proof bridge, create circuits from a solar cell, and experience real-world coding and environmental impact studies. The students also learned presentation skills and participated in team-building activities. The students also gained an understanding of what it is like to live in a dorm environment.

Spring Middle School Academy will occur from April 5-11.
