<u>FIT</u>

When students begin exploring their steps for after graduation one of the considerations is "Is this the right fit for me?" When thinking of the concept of FIT we are looking at the following:

- The right mix of challenge, opportunity, and support needed to help students advance your growth and achievement of goals.
- The atmosphere of the college/university/training program.
- Academic reputation-how seriously do student take their studies?
- Social reputation-how seriously do students take their non-studying?
- Flexibility-can students spend the first one/two years exploring majors, or must they declare right away?
- Friendliness-how supportive and accessible are college personnel in helping students?
- Competitiveness-how supportive are students of one another?
