Board Report

July 10, 2025

1. **Transportation Negotiations** - A tentative agreement has been reached with the Minooka Transportation Association. A draft of the agreement is in your board materials for consideration and approval. The transportation association has already ratified the agreement.
2. **Audit** - The Board's auditor has started their preliminary field work onsite. We anticipate a smooth and timely audit process.
3. **Purchase of Special Education Vans** - We are in the process of purchasing new vans to support our transportation special education students. Our current vans have very high mileage and have maintenance issues. We will also start the process of purchasing the vehicles needed to support district 111 supplying district 201 transportation. The transportation department have investigated the best cost effective solution and believe purchasing 1-2 year old vans with low mileage would suit their purposes. In your board materials are quotes for 4 vans, 20 for 111 and 2 for 201.
4. **Construction** - Weekly construction meetings continue with the administration, construction manager, and architect. Significant progress is being made at the South Campus. The Central Campus is having a lot of work done on the roof and interior getting ready to tie in the new wing. Installation of the construction road and outside demolition should start in the next 2 weeks.
