DOOR-TO-DOOR SALES	The District prohibits door-to-door sales for charitable or school- sponsored activities for all elementary and <b>middle school junior</b> high grade levels. [See GE(REGULATION)]
FOR OUTSIDE ORGANIZATIONS	Students representing their school may participate in charitable institution and community drives. Such participation shall be on a strictly voluntary basis, shall not disrupt the regular school day, and shall be open to students in grades 40 9-12.
BY OUTSIDE ORGANIZATIONS	No outside organizations of any sort may solicit contributions of any type from students within the schools.
LOSS OF CLASS TIME	The collection of monies that takes the time of the students or teachers during school hours is strictly forbidden, unless the mon- ies collected represent payment for school lunches, monies that will benefit the school or its students, or other authorized fees. [See also FP]
	The Board shall regularly be informed of approved fund-raising projects and shall periodically review the effect of such activity on the student body, the instructional program, and the community.
