10 11	Superintendent, will adopt and maintain procedures to implement this policy.
12	In addition, the Board takes seriously the issue of chronic absenteeism. To address this
13	issue, the Board, through its Superintendent, will adopt and maintain procedures
14	regarding chronic absenteeism in accordance with state law.
