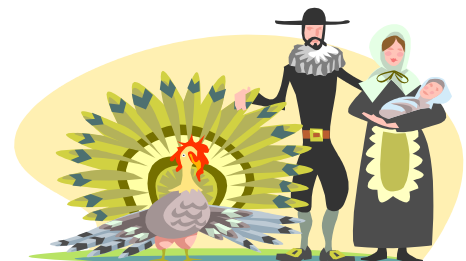

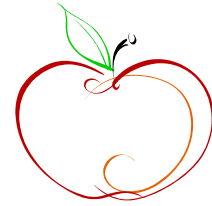

## School Partnership Program

Encouraging children to read falls heavily on our local school libraries. With funding cuts, being able to purchase books that are in demand is often very difficult. To assist our library, we have a partnership program to provide a direct credit to our school library which can be used at any time.

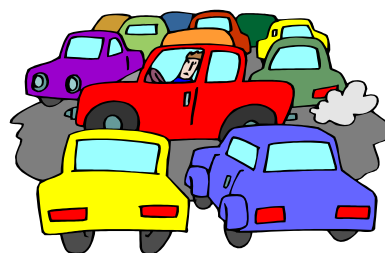
The program works like this: Any supporter who mentions our school when purchasing books triggers a donation of 5% of the total purchase to our school account. (no institutional discounts allowed on this program). When our supporters order books through [oregonbooks.com](http://oregonbooks.com), just add your schools name in the comments section or mention it when they pick up their books.

As an example of how all this works, if you have only 50 supporters buying \$10.00 worth of books each month, your library would have \$300 during the year to spend.



### Removing the Clog.....

If you are picking up students after school please do not **PARK** in front of the office . There are parents who need to keep circulating or park in a space to wait for your student. We have had some complaints by parents who have students ready to load and go and they are being detained by having to wait behind parked cars in the loading and unloading zone.

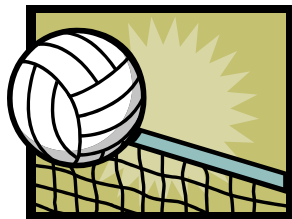
If your student wishes to remain after school for a game there is a procedure to follow:

1. Student must have a note and bring it to our office with your permission to stay.

2. Student must have an adult responsible for them here at time of game and we need to know that information in their note to our office, the person accepting this responsibility must let us know of that request.

3. This must all be taken care of before game day.

We do not allow students to remain after school without parent permission and we do not allow students to phone home to gain this permission. The notes may be brought into our office the day before or the day of the game with the arrangements already made. This has always been our policy for the safety of your student(s).
