All agreements are contingent upon strike, accidents or delays beyond our control. Lifeway Mobility and all of our dedicated subcontractors carry Workers' Compensation and General Liability Insurance on proposed work. Owner is to carry fire, tornado and other necessary insurance upon above work. We reserve the right to take photographs prior to starting work and upon completion. Manufacturer's standard warranty covers 12- months repair or replacement of parts due to defective material or workmanship. Lifeway Mobility provides a 12- months labor warranty for the repair or replacement of warranty parts. *Maintenance agreement extends the equipment warranty to 3-years. Extended warranties available contact Lifeway Mobility for details. Vandalism, Acts of God, tampering and misuse are not covered by the warranties. Terms of warranty shall begin at the time of substantial completion.

A contract that's broken before lift is ordered is subject to a minimum 20% restocking and or cancellation fee. Equipment that has been ordered and is in production cannot be canceled and no refunds or exchanges will be allowed. By signing this agreement client agrees to pay any collection costs incurred to collect the account balance, including court costs, collection fees and attorney's fees. Any returned checks will carry a \$50.00 service charge.

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Client/GC Responsibilities

Work by Others:

- Dedicated 120V 15A power supply to lockable disconnect.
- Remove handrail

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Work by Lifeway Mobility:

- Mount manufacturer supplied rails, posts, and brackets to the existing concrete stairs.
- Mount lift to rail and make all necessary adjustments for operation.
- Make final hook-up from power disconnect to lift system.
- Make final hook-ups of landing controls to lift system.

Permits:

Typical Elevator permit and inspection cost is included, cost allowance \$300. Cost of blueprints, drawings, plats of surveys, descriptions, features, or inspections, not mentioned in the above proposal that may be required by the City permitting authorities are not included. Lifeway Mobility will provide typical manufacturer's mechanical drawings for permit.

<u>Ordering and Installation:</u> Permitting time required by the authority having jurisdiction is approximately 4 weeks. Equipment will be ordered after permits are issued. Manufacturer's delivery time of equipment from date of release is approximately 6-8 weeks. Total amount of time needed for installation is approximately 3-5 days.

All work shall meet current applicable building code requirements. Lifeway Mobility and all its sub-contractors agree to carry Workers' Compensation and General Liability Insurance as specified in documents.

Any alteration or deviation from above specifications involving extra costs, will be executed only upon written orders, and will become an extra charge. Price quote is good for 30 days.

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
