	Provides enjoyable activities that bring seniors together for great social interaction.		
	These can include, but are not limited to: Bingo, Dominoes, Workout Classes, Birthday		
	& Holiday Parties, Educational Presentations, Nutritional Education Classes, and Student-Sponsored activities.		
	The Senior Citizen Center's activities are held daily, Monday through Friday along with		
	the congregate meal program. A special afternoon activity program is provided on		
	select dates at the Wharton Center from 2:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m.		
	• 2 fundraisers are held per year – 2 for Wharton County and 2 for Colorado County
