3260, "Disposal of Obsolete Books, Equipment, and Supplies"

On March 21, 2022, the Board accepted the attached proposed new Policy 3260 for 30-Day Review; it has been drafted to establish guidelines for disposal of materials based on current recommendations of the Connecticut Association of Boards of Education (CABE), and is brought forward to you now for adoption.

Business/Non-Instructional Operations**Disposal of Obsolete Books, Equipment and Supplies**

The Superintendent shall be authorized to dispose of obsolete books, equipment or supplies valued at less than \$2,000, and shall report such disposal to the Board of Education. The disposal of books, equipment, or supplies valued at \$2,000 or more requires approval of the Board of Education.

Items with useful life or monetary value may be sold at public sale. If items are otherwise disposed, disposal shall be conducted whenever possible following guidelines supporting best recycling and reuse practices.

If property acquired under grant funds is disposed of, such disposal shall follow grant procedures and applicable State and federal guidelines.
