### **Subject**

Consideration and Approval of Members for the Local School Library Advisory Council

### **Background Information**

In accordance with Texas Education Code § 33.025, as amended by the 89th Texas Legislature, school districts may establish a Local School Library Advisory Council (LSLAC) to provide guidance and recommendations on the acquisition and reconsideration of library materials.

The council must:

Include a minimum of five voting members, appointed by the Board of Trustees;

- Have a majority of members who are parents of students enrolled in Weatherford ISD and who are not employed by the district;
- Meet at least twice per year to review proposed library acquisitions, reconsideration requests, and policies related to the selection and maintenance of library materials.

District librarians were asked to submit nominations for individuals willing to serve on the Council.
