TOPIC: Approval to Purchase French Textbooks - Levels 3,4,5

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District purchase *T'es Branché*, 2019 as the digital and hard copy textbook and curriculum for French 3, 4 and 5 from Carnegie Learning for all three of our high schools, for a total cost of \$42,798.00.

RATIONALE:

T'es Branché was adopted for French Levels I and II during the 2017-18 and 2018-19 school years and the committee wanted to provided consistency for students by having one common curriculum and textbook resource. The committee followed the district textbook adoption process and the high school principals support the recommendation. The recommendation has also been reviewed and supported by the Board Curriculum Committee. This purchase includes free teacher resources.

The purchase of French textbooks will be charged to the District's Secondary Textbook budget which has been supported by the Wayne County Enhancement Millage Monies.
