Please note, contributions made to various parent organizations, such as PTO's and Booster Clubs, are <u>NOT</u> contributions to the District. Since these organizations are separate entities from the District, the District's tax—exempt status does not apply to these organizations. These organizations must apply for their tax-exempt status under IRS Code Section 501(c)(3). Evidence of their tax-exempt status would be a Determination Letter from the IRS. When a PTO or Booster Club donates monetary or non-monetary items to the District, then the donation is considered a contribution to the District.
