INFORMATIONAL REPORT:
United Independent School District intends to participate in two school zone and school bus safety programs that staff believes would provide additional safety for our students as they arrive at campuses in the morning and leave in the afternoon and as they are transported on our school bus fleet.
The Speed Enforcement Solution Program consists of multiple options to capture pictures of vehicles that violate the posted speed limits in our school zones in the mornings and afternoons. Using the images captured, the vehicle's owner will be identified and a citation will be issued by our UISD Police Department and mailed to the registered address.
The School Bus Stop Arm Safety Program consists of cameras mounted on District school buses which capture images of vehicles that fail to stop when the bus's stop arm is deployed. As stated above, the

vehicle in the image will be identified and a citation will be issued and mailed to the registered address.

All capital outlay required will be provided by American Traffic Solutions at no cost to the District. Their compensation will be as a result of a percent allocation of all traffic fines received by the District as
