Medical Emergency Response Teams (MERT Teams)

- Every 2 years the school nurses train 5-7 staff members from each building to be members of their MERT teams. Our school MERT teams are certified in CPR & First Aid. They are trained to provide immediate, first-responder care for health crises like sudden cardiac arrest, seizure, or injuries, bridging the gap until professional EMS arrives. This helps to improve survival rates through CPR/AED use, coordinating care, and ensuring rapid, organized responses during various emergencies, ensuring student and staff safety. All school MERT teams will be trained this spring on **Friday Feb. 6th or Friday April 24th**.
