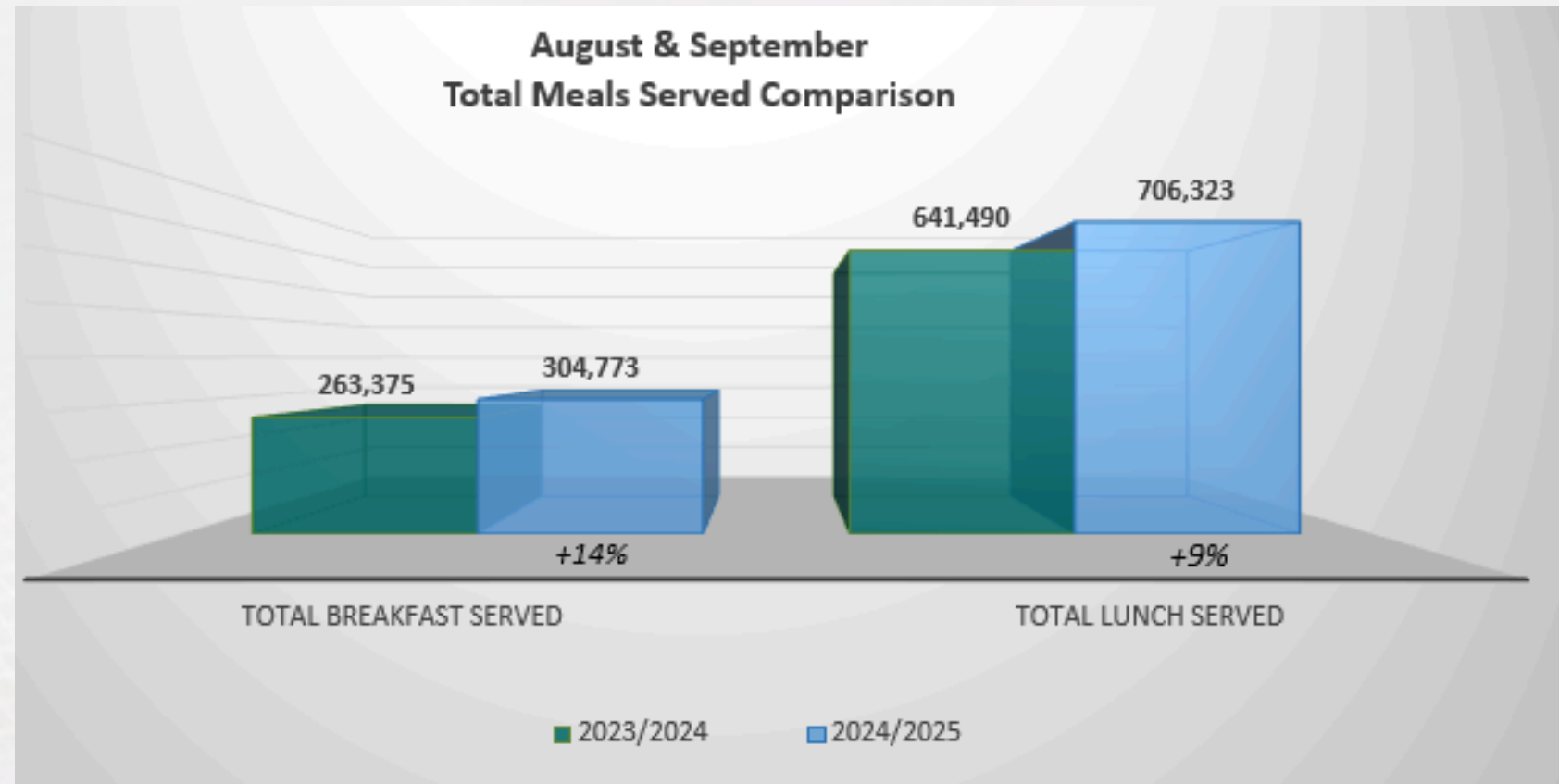

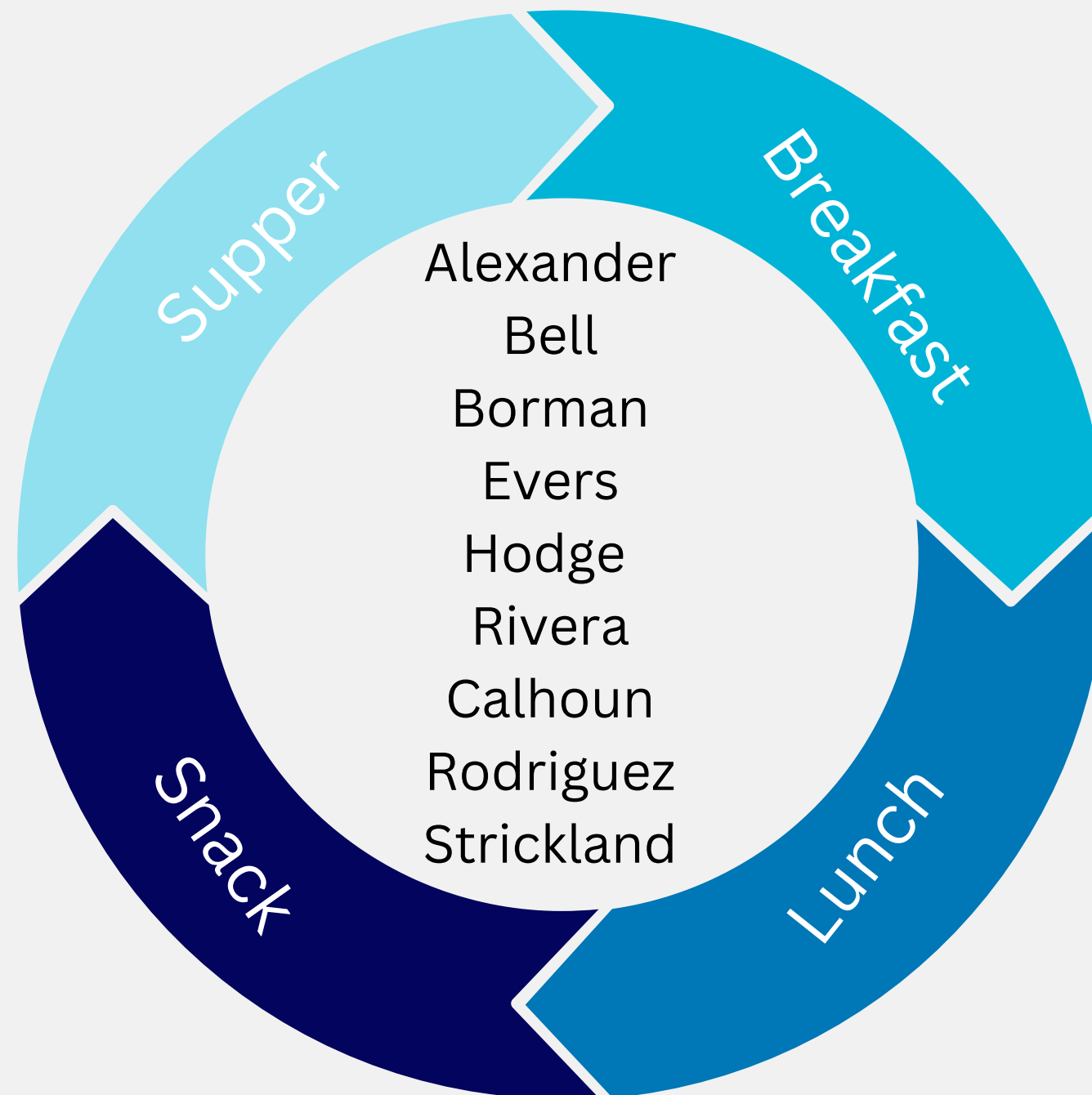
Community Eligibility Provision Program

CACFP-At Risk

The Child and Adult Care Food Program At Risk provides the opportunity for approved campuses to offer supper and a snack to students participating in an afterschool enrichment program



- ✓ Serving students participating in Community in Schools after school programs
- ✓ Currently providing meals at 9 campuses
- ✓ Supper served upon dismissal
- ✓ Over 4,000 supper meals served in September
