Re: Election of Board of Directors for the Ward County Appraisal District

As required by Section 6.03 of the Texas Property Tax Code, I have calculated the voting entitlement for those tax jurisdictions that are eligible to vote for the Board of Directors of the Ward County Appraisal District. The five directors that are elected will serve a two-year term beginning January 1, 2026. The number of votes calculated for each tax entity and the election procedures are as follows:

Ward County	1183
Monahans-Wickett-Pyote I.S.D.	2518
Grandfalls-Royalty I.S.D.	126
Pecos-Barstow-Toyah I.S.D.	1050
City of Monahans	117
City of Wickett	2
City of Grandfalls	1

*Before **October 15, 2025*** each jurisdiction may nominate up to five board members and notifies the Chief Appraiser of the nominee(s). I have enclosed a resolution for use in submitting the nominations.

*Before **October 30, 2025*** the Chief Appraiser prepares a ballot listing the nominees and delivers a copy to the presiding officer of each of the governing bodies of the member jurisdictions.

*Before **December 15, 2025*** each jurisdiction must cast its vote by written resolution and submit it to the Chief Appraiser.

*Before **December 31, 2025*** the Chief Appraiser will tabulate the votes and the five nominees receiving the most votes will be declared elected to the Board of Directors. The Chief Appraiser will notify the nominees and the jurisdictions of the results.

**RESOLUTION TO NOMINATE CANDIDATE(S) TO SERVE
AS MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR
THE WARD COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT FOR THE

WHEREAS the 67TH Legislature of the State of Texas has passed H.B. 30 (Revisions to the Property Tax Code); and

WHEREAS there was not sufficient number of voting taxing units in the Ward County Appraisal District that filed with the Appraisal District a resolution to change the selection process; and

WHEREAS there will be an election to elect five directors to serve a two-year term beginning **January 1, 2026**; and

WHEREAS each voting taxing unit may nominate one candidate for each position to be filled on the board of directors; the taxing unit may nominate one to five candidates since the board of directors consists of five members; and

WHEREAS eligibility and restrictions for service on the Appraisal District Board of Directors are defined in Section 6.035 of the Property Tax Code;


