For the Panel's Consideration

• Enrollment increase of 1,000 students to a total cap of 4,000 to ensure any student requesting admission in the current COVID crisis is not turned away.



Current Enrollment and Forecast

- 2813 currently active enrollments
- 575 applications in process
 - 76% transfer rate from application to active enrollment
- Projected enrollment 3,250
- July and August have the highest enrollment yield

Current Academic Progress

- Increase in students making a minimum of one year's growth (Star360)
 - 22% improvement YOY
 - 14% improvement K-2
 - 13% improvement 3-5
 - 29% improvement 6-8
 - 21% improvement HS
- Continued participation success
 - 96% total participation for online assessments
 - 99% participation in grades K-5





- Teacher Satisfaction Continues to Climb
 - 80% teacher satisfaction
 - 76% SY 18-19
 - 56% SY 17-18
- Successful Teacher Return Rate
 - 97.7% returning for SY 20-21
- Family Satisfaction Rising
 - 86% family satisfaction
 - 76% SY 18-19
 - 75% SY 17-18
