- I recently submitted information for 1 of the 5 components of the Trusted Learning Environment certification. I am waiting to hear back from the review process and will keep the Board updated. - We are working toward earning the designation of being a "<u>Trusted Learning</u> <u>Environment</u>" through a certification process via the Consortium for School Networking (CoSN).
- This process helps us strengthen our data privacy practices to ensure we are doing everything we can to protect the data of our stakeholders.
- While we believe our data privacy practices are currently strong, we believe we can always improve, and this process will help us to do so.
