Referrals by Race

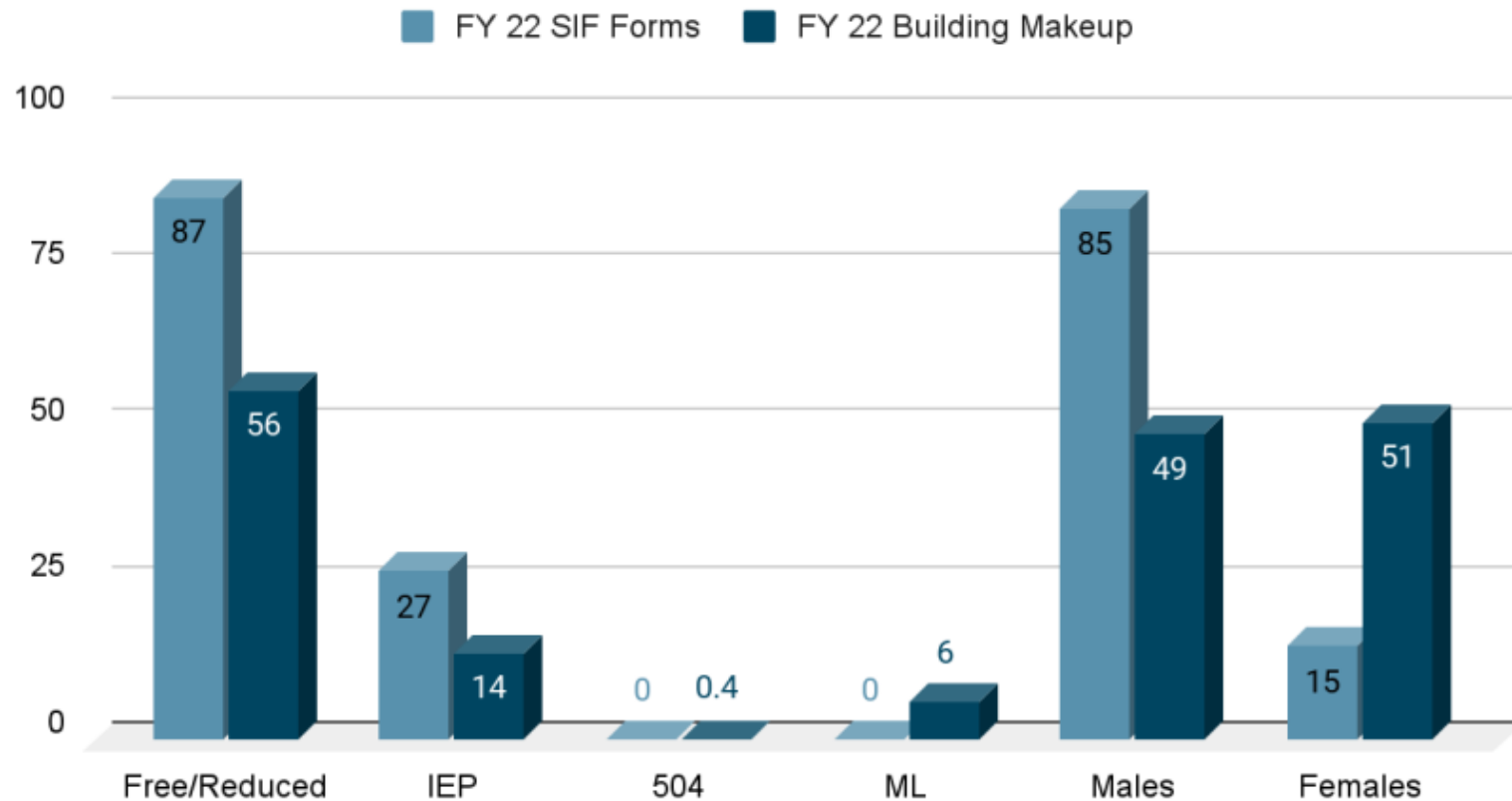

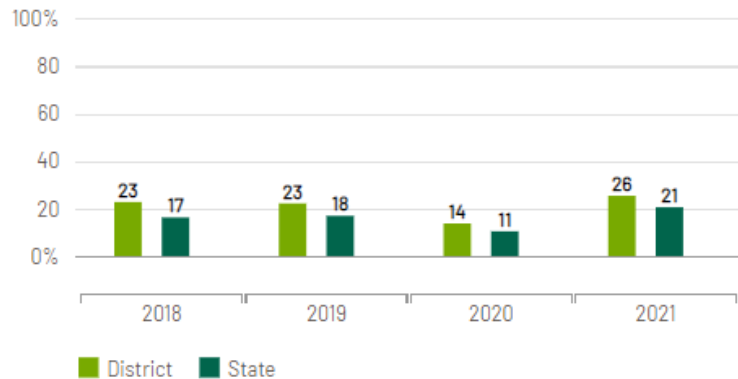
All Students - 2017-21

Chronic Absenteeism

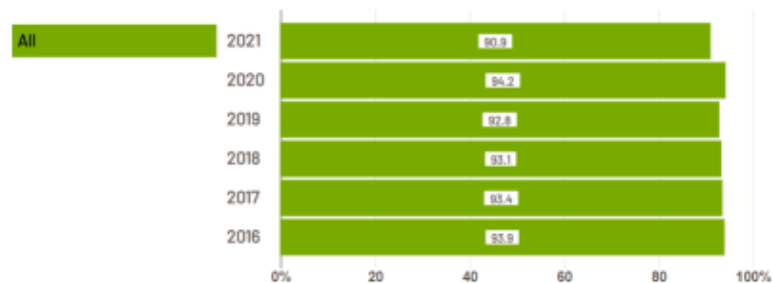
All Students - 2018-21
