I. Updated Todd Hall and Rutledge Hall Door Project Schedule

Athi Toufexis recapped the scope of the door replacement project. The Committee viewed renderings of the complete look of the classroom entrances, the Committee preferred the look with the curved soffit. The Committee chose to repaint the exterior door frames and omit the molding of the interior classroom alcoves once the entrance renovations are complete.

Athi Toufexis presented the options for the classroom locks. The Committee recommended a keyed lock on both sides of the door with a visual indicator that shows whether the door is locked or unlocked from the outside.

IV. Todd Hall Plaza Lighting The exterior work is complete. The contractor will be returning the week of Thanksgiving to complete the interior work.
