**Wilson Elementary once again named TBEC Honor Roll school**

Woodrow Wilson Elementary has been named one of the top elementary schools in the state by the Texas Business and Education Coalition, which placed the school on its prestigious Honor Roll School list for 2009. This is the second year in a row for the school to receive this honor.

Of the more than 8,000 Texas public schools, less than four percent were selected. These schools will be honored at a reception on Nov. 9 in San Antonio.

This honor reflects the school's commended rates being over the 51.6% in all areas tested, including reading, writing, math and science.

The TBEC identifies Honor Roll schools by analyzing three years of performance data for every public school in Texas. A TBEC Honor Roll school must have a high percentage of students meeting state standards on every TAKS test for three consecutive years.

The TBEC Honor Roll schools also have the highest percentage of students performing at the state's most rigorous standard of commended in every subject. The selection criteria also considers the school's demographics, number of subjects tested and grade levels. Wilson, a Title 1 school, also was named a "Recognized" school by the Texas Education Agency in August.

Audrey Staniszewski, principal, and Lorena Salas, assistant principal, and the entire Wilson staff are to be commended for these outstanding efforts.
