**Agenda Item 1F2 – Surplus**

**Purpose:** Action Recommended

**Background:** Board Policy DN requires that District property be declared surplus property before it is disposed of. This requires Board approval.

The items to be declared surplus are 2 modular buildings, 1 steel framed warehouse, and the contents inside those buildings at Molalla River Middle School. This is in preparation for construction of the new middle school building. The 3 buildings are not able to be moved or sold, and are in poor shape. The items stored at the warehouse are either obsolete, broken, or not needed anymore. Some examples are furniture, power tools not approved to be used in schools, miscellaneous obsolete technology like computers, printers, overhead projectors, etc.

The District will contract with a company this summer to remove, recycle, dispose, and repurpose usable items to non-profit organizations – including local non-profits and sending items to impoverished schools in other countries (e.g. Honduras, Mongolia, and Liberia, and Tanzania).
