| <p>Online School Approval</p> | <p>A board member asked about the status of GCED's application to the state for approval of using Edgenuity.</p> <p>On October 5th, Cherie Johnson reported that the application requesting approval for the online schooling arrangement with Edgenuity is in the hands of the Minnesota Department of Education (MDE). Everything is complete and all feedback has been extremely positive. There are no additional paperwork requirements to turn in at this time.</p> <p>The final step in the process is a site visit. The MDE was not available to complete the site visit until October 12th. They have told us to continue to do what we are doing and that they look forward to completing the final step on the 12th.</p> <p>As soon as the MDE provides GCED with their official response, Cherie Johnson will send it to the school board. Cherie believes part of the delay in scheduling the site visit is the number of districts that are going through the same process.</p> |
