- authorizes Schwartz & Eichelbaum Wardell Mehl and Hansen, P.C. to consult with the Superintendent to approve the final Notice of Proposed Nonrenewal and to take whatever actions are necessary and proper to present the case in support of the proposed nonrenewal; and
