2025-2026 SUPERINTENDENT PRIORITIES/GOALS

- Seek Supplemental Revenue Sources to Support District Operations and Programs for the 25-26 School Year No updates at this time.
- Support School Board in Process for Selecting New Superintendent [2026-2027 School Year]

The process is underway and ongoing. A district profile survey request was sent to me on August 29, 2025 from AASB and was completed and returned on that day.

Complete Long-Term Multi-Year Projects (ex: curriculum website; updates to job descriptions [staff, coaches, advisors]; de-escalation training for staff; credit-by-exam framework; bloodborne pathogen exposure control plan/policy; new van(s) purchase; etc.).

District Administration is in the process of soliciting quotes for a new van. The general cost will likely be in the \$70-\$75k range and can be covered with adequate funds in the Vehicle Replacement Fund.

POLICY REVIEW

• The Policy Committee met on August 26, 2025 to review Chapter 7000. At its next tentatively scheduled meeting in September, the Committee will begin review of a new section of AASB model policies: Section 10000 Charter Schools.

OTHER

• Tentative Temporary Closure of Copper River Highway 2026-2027

Per DOT, the Copper River Highway between Whitshed Road and Chase Avenue is scheduled to be closed to complete deep excavation and utility relocation for the Copper River Highway Odiak Slough Culvert Replacement project. The anticipated road closure will last approximately 45 days, sometime between September 30, 2026, and April 15, 2027. Specific dates and additional details will be forthcoming once the project is advertised and a contractor is selected.

A detour route around the project area has been considered via Chase Avenue and LeFevre Street. DOT reached out to the District recently to get comments about how this could affect school transportation.
