Health and Safety Management Assistance SERVICE AGREEMENT

The above named member requests **Health and Safety Management Assistance** pursuant to the following conditions:

Term of Service: July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018

The Southeast Service Cooperative Health and Safety Management Assistance Provider, CESA 10, will provide the following services:

- 1. Identify and prioritize health and safety concerns.
- 2. Perform a mock OSHA audit and follow-up visit at each district to identify hazards and prevent redevelopment of hazards.
- 3. CESA will utilize the expertise of their technical staff to perform these audits using our iAuditor software. The detailed reports will include the project name, facility/site location, date and time of the audit, consultants performing the audit, and general facility information including building occupancy. It will also highlight issues requiring action, such as:
 - Environmental health and safety findings in each audited area
 - Descriptions of the findings
 - Room numbers or area location of the findings
 - Pictures of the findings
 - Suggestive corrective actions for the district wherever possible
- 4. During these audits, CESA will look to identify any issues in direct violation of Department of Labor & Industry (DLI), Minnesota OSHA, and Federal OSHA compliance. Most common findings include, but are not limited to: shop safety, lack of machine guarding, improper chemical storage, exposure to blood borne pathogens, blocking electrical panels, and entering confined spaces.
 - Audits will be completed during the fall of 2017 by a team of CESA experts.
 - A follow-up contact with each district will be provided in the spring of 2018 to review action items/issues identified in the initial audit as well as review of mandatory training records with district personnel.

In addition to the mock-OSHA services outlined above, Southeast Service Cooperative will:

- 1. Serve as an informational resource regarding current Long-Term Facility Maintenance and Health & Safety issues.
- 2. Provide third party evaluation and/or confirmation for Long-Term Facility Maintenance and Health & Safety funding.

Note: Health & Safety Management Assistance is outside the scope of the Basic Environmental Health & Safety Services provided by IEA.

Service Fee: The annual service fee is a base fee of \$375 for each district and .004 of a cent multiplied by the district's total square footage with a maximum of \$2,400. The Minnesota Department of Education has confirmed authorization for the district to levy for recovery of the balance (the net fee).
