RENEWAL OF GRANT #825 WITH CHANGES

Grant #825 was awarded at the August 26, 2008 Board meeting and was to be a 5 year term for MDE School Nurse Intervention Program (replacing the Tobacco Nurse Grant). The 5 year program was to be a gradual reduction in funds with an increase in District Match funds to add to \$50,000 per year. The 09-10 school year would have been the first reduction and increase in matching funds. However, the grant has again been fully funded in the amount of \$50,000. This money provides a school nurse who currently serves Carver, King and the Alternative Schools.
