# **Clinton Elementary School**

**Reason for Amendment:** Due to an unanticipated surplus from LAND Trust funds for the 2024-2025 school year, the Clinton Elementary School Community Council has voted to reallocate these surplus funds.

- Current Reading/Literacy & Math Goals (no changes needed):
- 1. Sixty-three percent of students in grades K-3 will make typical or greater progress as measured on Pathways of Progress from beginning of year to end of year. Students in grades 4-6 will make two percent growth of typical or greater progress from End of Year 2024 (School Year 2024) to End of Year 2025 (School Year 2025) as measured by Acadience Reading Pathways of Progress.
- 2. Sixty percent of students in grades 1-3 will make typical or greater progress on Pathways of Progress from beginning of year to end of year. Forty-two percent of students in Kindergarten will be at or above benchmark on Next Number Fluency from beginning of year to end of year as measured through Acadience Math.
- Proposed Action Plan Amendments for Academic Goals:

Re-allocate \$16,381.84 in unanticipated surplus funds to update and increase classroom and student technology to support effective classroom instruction to facilitate increased student learning. This will include replacing and upgrading individual student/staff laptops, purchasing classroom televisions and projectors, iPads, cases, and ScreenBeams.
