SUCCESSES

- Met standard in all four areas
- 81% of ELL students met or exceeded Progress on all assessments (19% exceeded progress)
- 90% of Economically Disadvantaged students met Level II Satisfactory Standard in Mathematics
- 91% of Hispanic students met Level II Satisfactory Standard in Mathematics
- 2/3 student groups increased level of performance in Index 4 Postsecondary Readiness from previous year.
- Attendance rate increased .5% in 2015-2016

CHALLENGES

- Continued focus on targeted student populations (ESL, Special Education, Economically Disadvantaged, Hispanic students) in particular in the areas of Reading and Science
- Raising the bar by increasing the number of Level III performances
- Student Attendance (previous year's goal was met, focus on continued growth)

WHAT'S NEXT

- Conduct data meetings concerning our most at-risk students with individual teachers to closely monitor student progress. Focus on the individual student and the appropriate intervention to help that student experience academic growth.
- Increased focus on engagement with students and their families to increase level of support at home.
- Daily flex time built into master schedule (30 minutes) to enrich learning.
- Increased opportunities for students to be recognized for their achievements, experience leadership opportunities, and have fun.
