## **Extracurricular and Co-Curricular Activities**

The Executive Director must approve an activity in order for it to be considered a Cooperative-sponsored extracurricular or co-curricular activity, using the following criteria:

- The activity will contribute to the leadership abilities, social well-being, self-realization, good citizenship, or general growth of student-participants.
- 2. Fees assessed students are reasonable and do not exceed the actual cost of operation.
- 3. The Cooperative has sufficient financial resources for the activity.
- 4. Requests from students.
- 5. The activity will be supervised by a school-approved sponsor.

Non-school sponsored student groups are governed by Board policy, 7:330, Student Use of Buildings - Equal Access.
