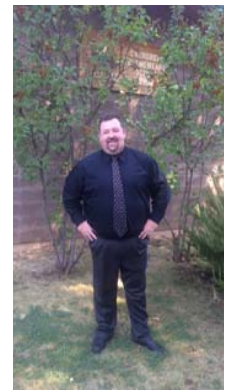
We look forward to meeting and working with each and every Evergreen family. You are always invited to contact us by sending a note, emailing, telephoning, or coming in to our office.
