**Subject:** Recommendation to accept Brady Elementary School's Fire Panel Replacement.

**The Issue:**

East Aurora School District 131 2026 Brady Fire Panel Bid Results.

**Justification:**

The fire panel at Brady Elementary School is old, and the system panel needs to be replaced to ensure student safety and emergency response. The district went out to bid to replace the panel. Only one (1) bid was received on Thursday, December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025, in a public meeting.

**Board Policy:**

Pursuant to Board Policy 4:60, Supplies, materials, or work involving an expenditure in excess of \$25,000 must comply with the State law bidding procedure, 105 ILCS 5/10-20.21, unless specifically exempted.

**Strategic Plan:**

This recommendation supports Strategic Goal #2, Operational Excellence that states the following: *East Aurora School District 131 will align and utilize systems and resources that promote operational excellence, efficiency, and fiscal accountability.*

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve Elite Technology Systems fire panel replacement base bid #1 for Brady Elementary School in the amount of \$355,890.

Dear Dr. Halverson:

On December 4, 2025, bids were received for the 2026 Fire Panel Replacement project at Brady Elementary School. The project was publicly advertised on November 7, 2025, and a mandatory Pre-Bid meeting was held virtually on November 14, 2025. Bids were received for the projects Base Bid Scopes of Work, and no alternate bids were considered. One (1) single bid was received and opened.

The Base Bid #1 (Brady Elementary School) total value was higher than the estimate for this project; \$106,000 over estimated budget (including a \$25,000 contingency allowance). It is our opinion that the values listed in the Facility Master Plan document are now outdated and should be re-evaluated based on current construction trends. At the post bid interview, Elite Technology Systems confirmed that tariffs have influenced escalated costs compared to last year's bid at Rollins Elementary. Fire alarm panels and components primarily come from Mexico and have seen a spike of almost 40% with tariffs imposed. We were informed that there has also been an increased labor shortage for contractors specializing in this area of work. For this reason, we would not expect the cost to come down if the project were to be rebid later.

Elite Technology Systems, the apparent low bidder, was interviewed following the bid opening and appears to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the work requested. Elite Technology Systems has successfully completed multiple fire panel replacement projects in the district, most recently this past summer at Rollins Elementary School. We are confident in their ability to deliver the project on time and within the contract value.

Attached is a summary of the bid results for: East Aurora School District 131, 2026 Fire Panel Replacement Project, for use at the January 5, 2026 B&G committee Meeting and the January 20, 2026 Board Meeting for direction with award of the Base Bid #1 (Brady Elementary School).

We recommend award of Elite Technology Systems' Base Bid #1 per the following:
