### **\*Family Advocate\***

We, would like to introduce Ms. Jennifer Hanscom, our new Librarian and Family Advocate. Ms. Hanscom has been working hard on getting the library open for our students and staff. She is also excited to start helping our students and families. As the Family Advocate she is responsible for the Cougar Closet (clothing, hygiene supplies, school supplies, etc. for all students), Food Pantry (to help students and families in need), and other resources.

A Family Advocate uses the following definitions to help students and families, however Ms. Hanscom is willing to help all students to the best of her ability:

McKinney Vento (Federally Funded Program) definitions:

- Homeless: Individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. Examples include: Shelters, Unsheltered, Shared Housing, Hotel/Motel.
- Houselessness can be caused for many reasons including evictions, natural disasters, economic hardship, and many other reasons. Houselessness also includes: Place not ordinarily designated for human accommodation such as, cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard or overcrowded housing.
- Migrant children who live in situations such as those described above
- Unaccompanied Youth-youth not in the physical custody of a parent or legal guardian-no age minimum or maximum.
