## Curriculum and Instruction

- The 25.26 NBHS Curriculum Guide is submitted for approval
  - We need to add a senior level math course as an alternate option. Currently we have Calculus and Statistical Reasoning. As per ISBE recommendation, Transition Math should be offered to seniors. Students that take this course and earn a C or higher are considered Career Ready. We have added the STEM and Technical Math options for approval, but will likely select one for next year for students to select.

### Assessment

- ASVAB testing for all Juniors was cancelled on Friday. The administrator who was scheduled to come and give
  the assessment was unable to come to our school. We will send out more information about when it will be
  rescheduled as soon as we have it.
- All 9th-11th Grade Students will take the Winter Benchmark iReady Math and Reading Diagnostic Assessment beginning Monday, December 9th. This is the benchmark testing that we use to determine placements in Reading or Math Intervention, so please stress to your child the importance of taking these assessments seriously and doing their best!
- All high school students will take the Panorama Winter Benchmark Survey next week during Advisory.
