<u>Attendance</u>

We are reaching out to set up conferences with families whose children exhibit chronic absenteeism. I know these are not easy conversations to have, but we have some students who continue to miss school at a rate that is extremely detrimental to learning. With the Read's Act, it is important that families are aware that children not performing close to grade level can be held back. In some cases, we are seeing attendance as a piece of this.
