






- Designed for artistically and academically thlented students. High School and Middle School housed at the same building.

- Candidates must meet the academic (60% GPA), attendance and discipline requirements in order to qualify for an audition at the academy. Audition determines acceptance.








- Focus is equipping all students with 21st century skils.
