Border Federal Credit Union's Professionals United to Leading a Successful Economy (PULSE) is a young professionals committee all employed by Border Federal Credit Union. The PULSE is dedicated to helping the community we all share by holding various events and fundraisers ensuring that all the money goes back into Border Federal Credit Union's scholarship fund for students and teachers.
