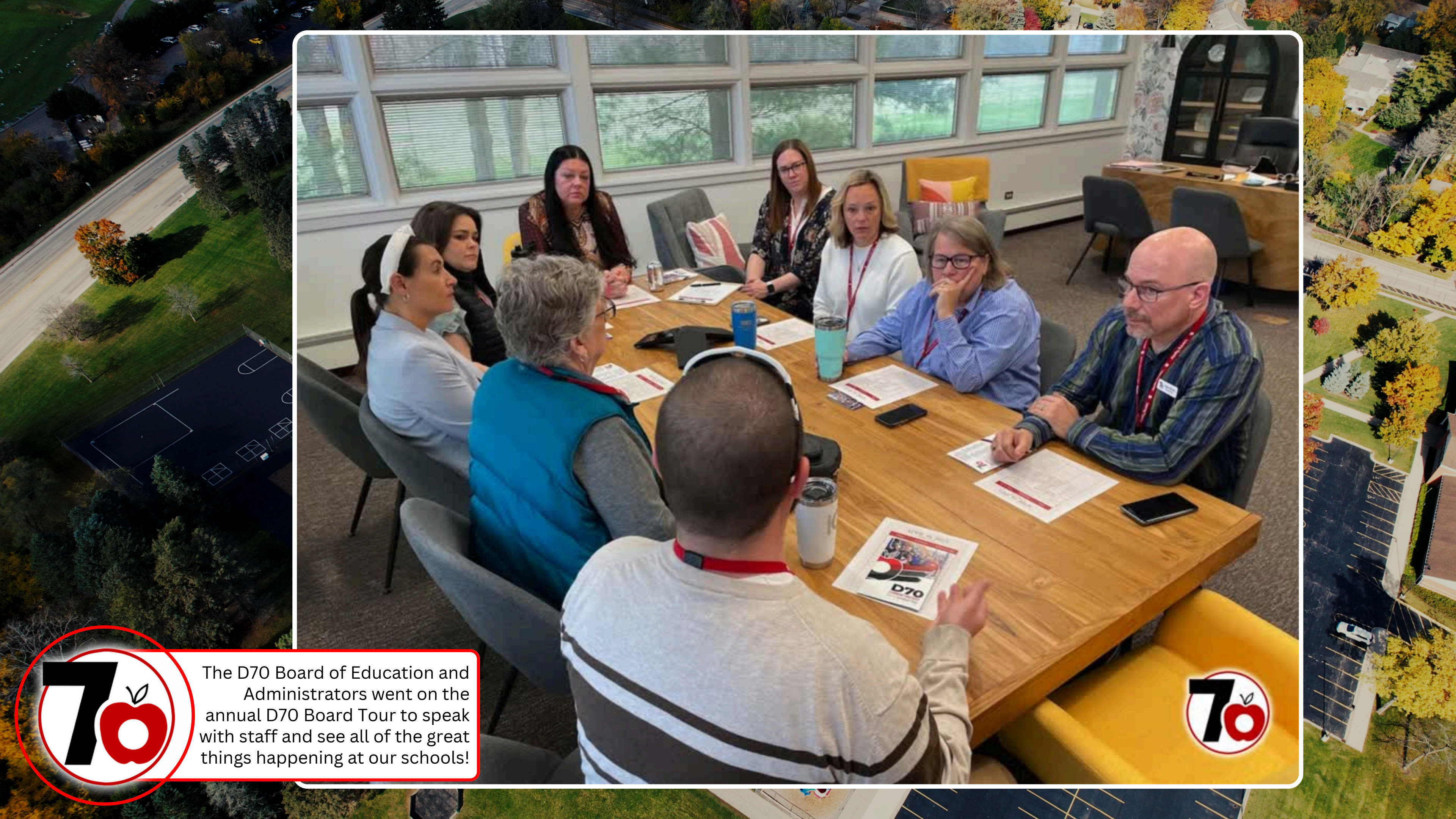

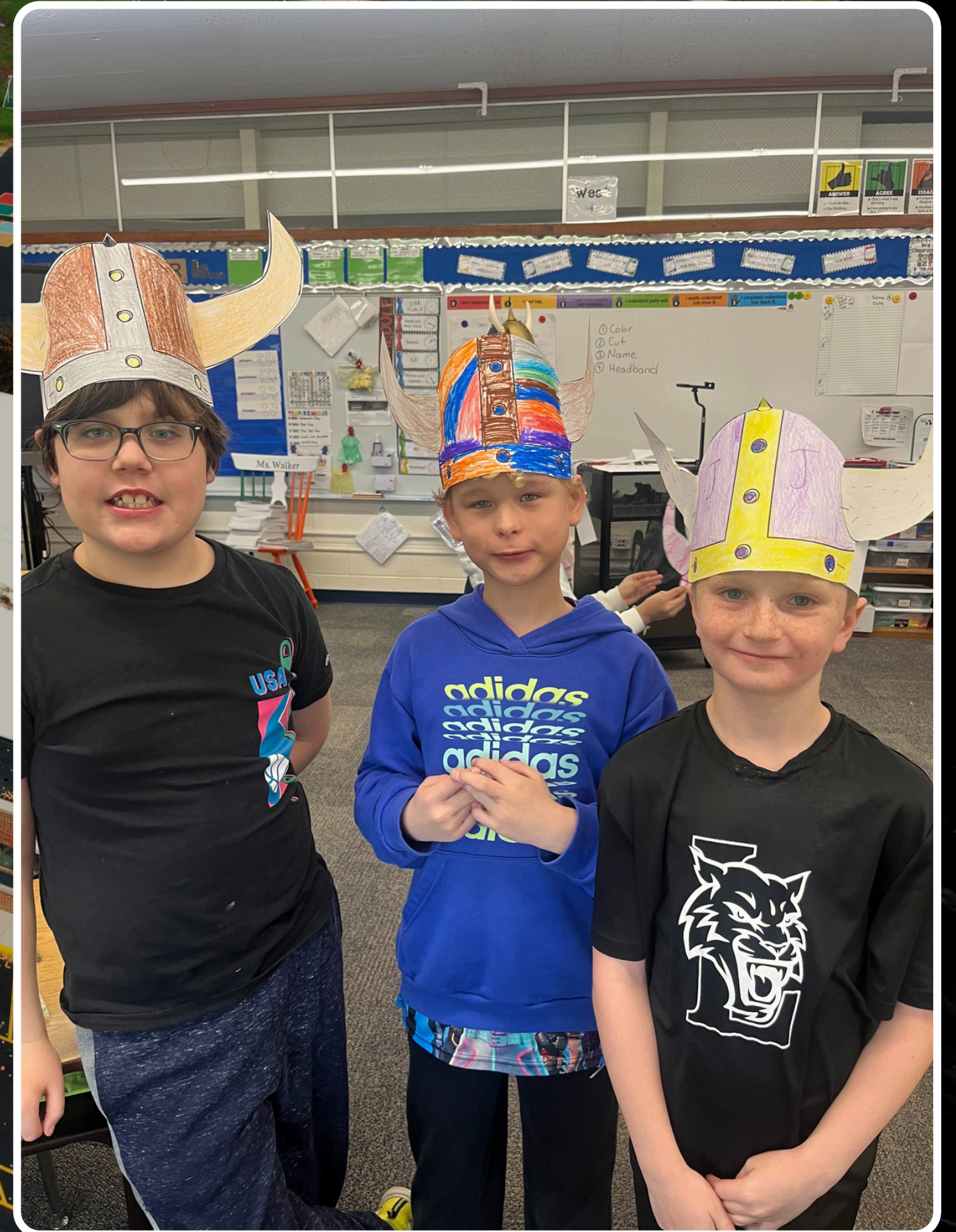


The D70 Board of Education and Administrators went on the annual D70 Board Tour to speak with staff and see all of the great things happening at our schools!





2nd graders at Adler Park had a blast creating their own insects, and 3rd graders designed Viking helmets while learning about Vikings in CKLA!

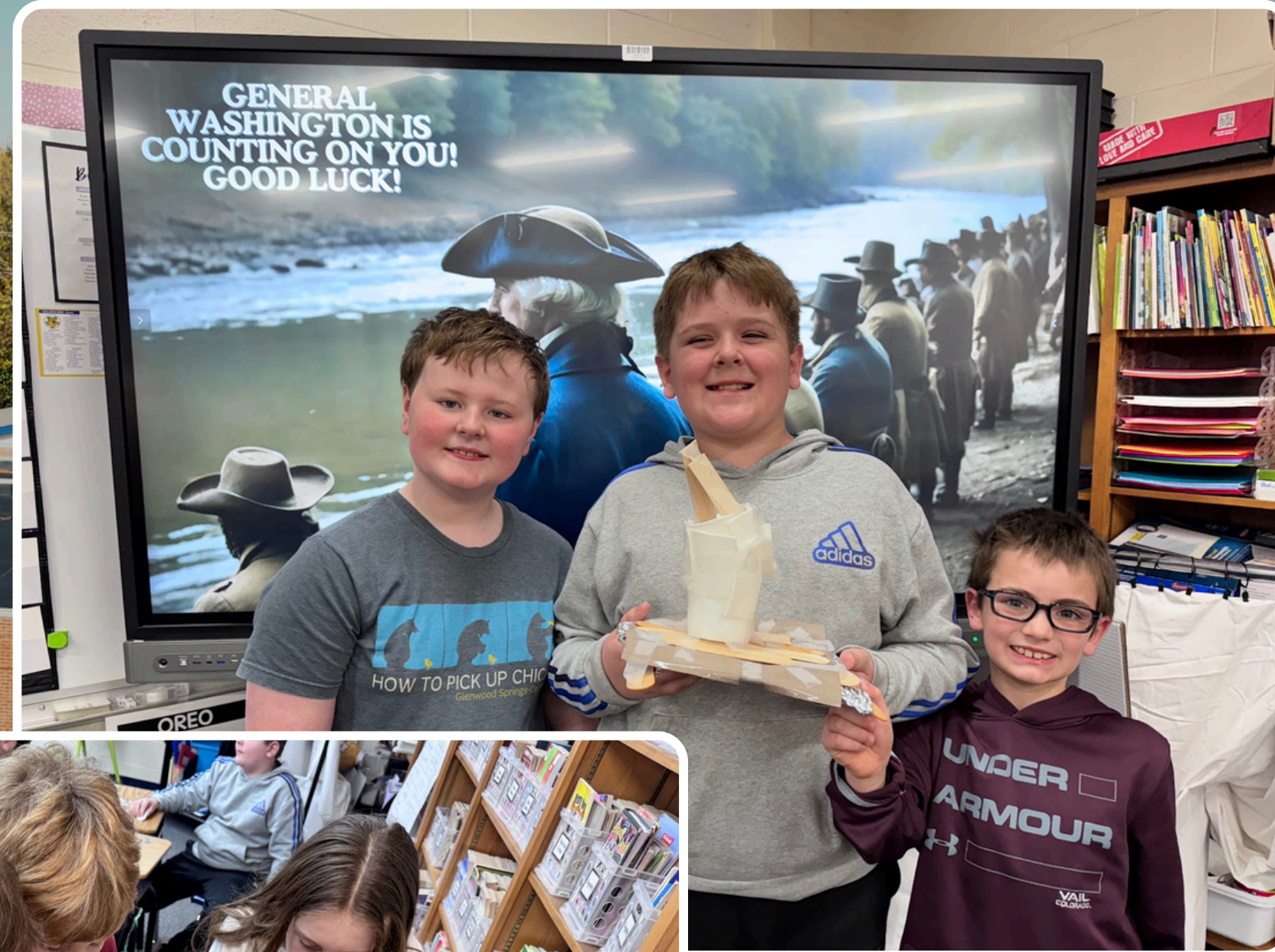




Butterfield students used cake pop sticks and play-doh to create 3D shapes and learn about geometry.

4th graders in Mrs. Vipond's class worked to create a boat to help George Washington cross the Delaware River in a recent STEM activity!



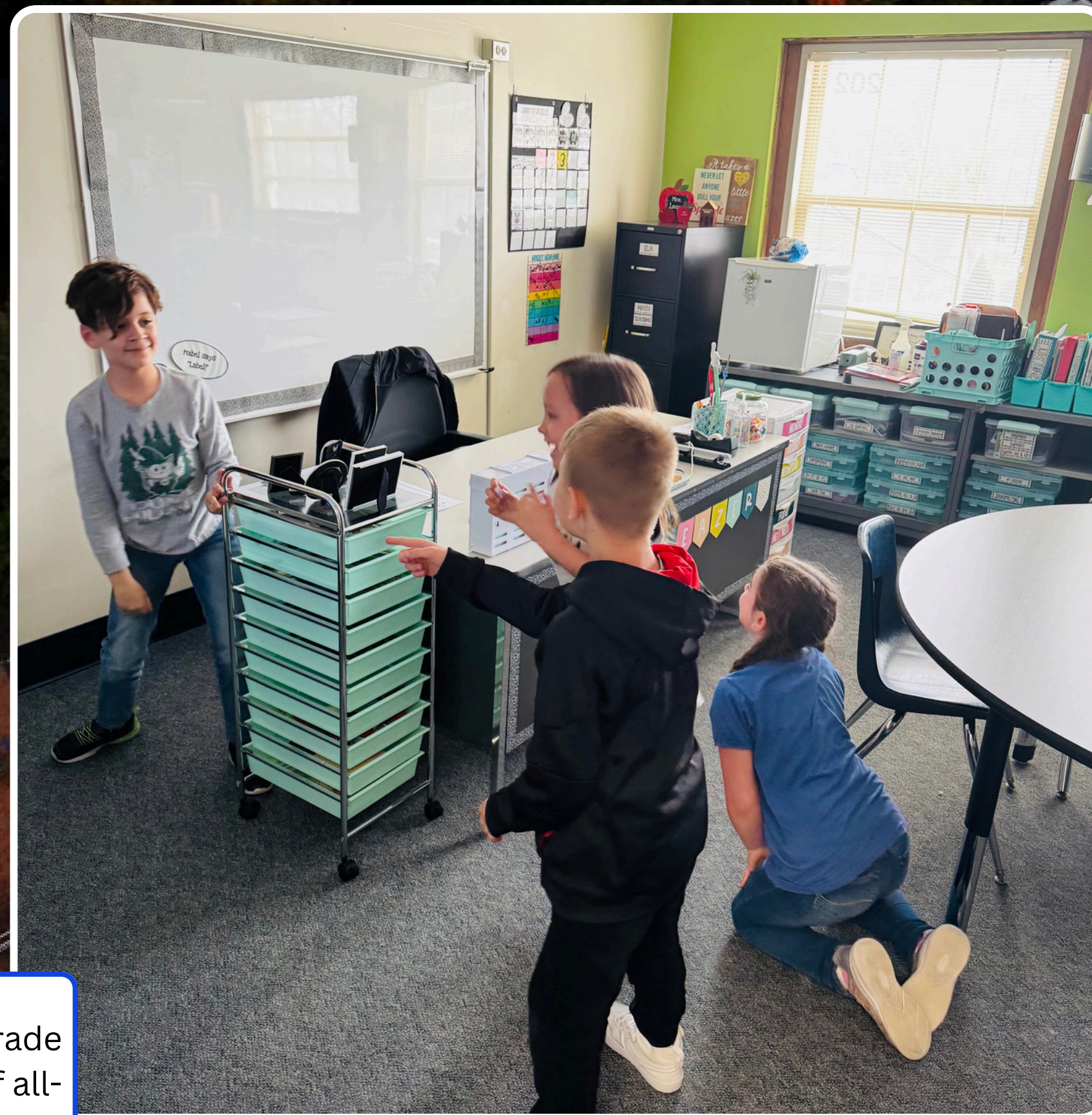
