Improving Customer Service & Staff Safety

- Sodexo offers all employees training, when hired, annually (every August), monthly and weekly throughout the school year.
- To insure the environment we work in, and the food we serve is safe, monthly food & physical safety trainings are held. Internal safety audits are performed monthly.
- Food and Sanitation Inspections are done by the Kane County Health department at every school One - Two Times Per School Year. This past fall we scored 100% at 8 Schools!

- **Sodexo** hires an outside company to perform physical and food safety inspections. EcoSure an Ecolab company does this yearly audit. They make sure we have all are Physical Safety & Food Safety, OSHA Regulation and HACCP logs completed and up to date. This school year two schools had the audit done with scores between 98 & 100%.

- **Hired High School Students to help market the food service program.**

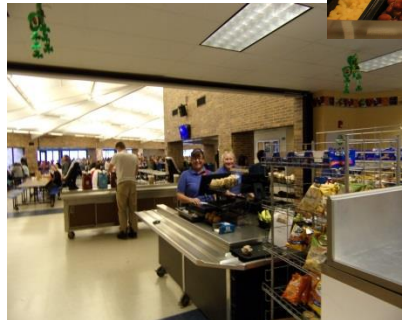
